

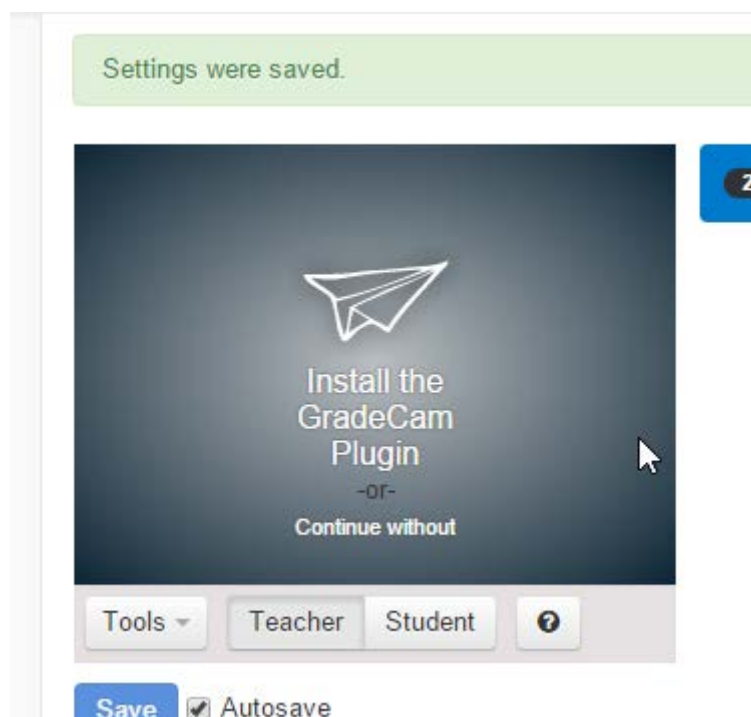
Google Chrome and Gradecam

Gradecam has always used a plug-in architecture (NPAPI) to interact with Illuminate Education. This plug-in uses an older method to interface with the web browser, and as of September 1, 2015, Google has dropped all support for NPAPI. (see <https://support.google.com/chrome/answer/6213033?hl=en>)

In order to use Gradecam with Chrome, Illuminate has implemented a new “Gradecam without plug-in” method. Information on this new method can be found at:

When teachers scan assessments, they will be presented with the “Install Plug-in Screen, or Continue Without”.



They should click the “Continue without” and Chrome should connect to their webcam and scanning can proceed. However, this “no plug-in” method does NOT work with ELMOs. Teachers that use an ELMO will need to switch to a different browser that still supports the NPAPI method, such as Firefox or Internet Explorer.
