

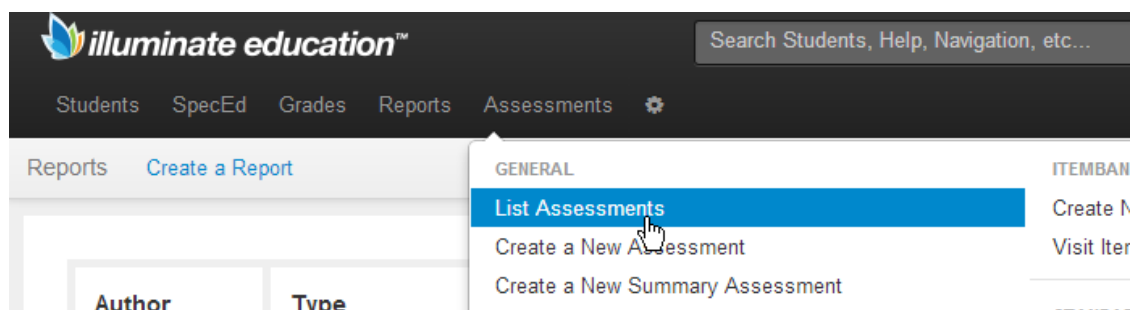
## Using the AIMSweb Rate of Improvement (ROI) report

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Use the Illuminate Education pre-built report "AIMSweb Rate of Improvement (ROI)" report to view grade level average annual rate of improvement on specific AIMSweb measures, as well as in comparison to the national ROI.

NOTE: This report will not display data for the current school year until after the spring scores are loaded. The rate of improvement is calculated as the difference between the spring score and the fall score, divided by 36 weeks. This calculation is unavailable for the current year until the spring test data is uploaded.

### Go to the Assessment List



Log onto Illuminate. From the top navigation bar, select Assessments>List Assessments.

## Locate the AIMSweb Rate of Improvement (ROI) report (filter method)

You can narrow the report list in a couple of ways. First, you could use the filters feature of Illuminate. Start by clearing any filters by pressing the "Clear" button (Step 1). Next, select "Prebuilt" in the Type column (Step 2) and aimsweb in the Tags column (Step 3). Hit Search (Step 4). A shortened list of prebuilt reports should appear. Click on the report named "AIMSweb Rate of Improvement (ROI)" (Step 5).
